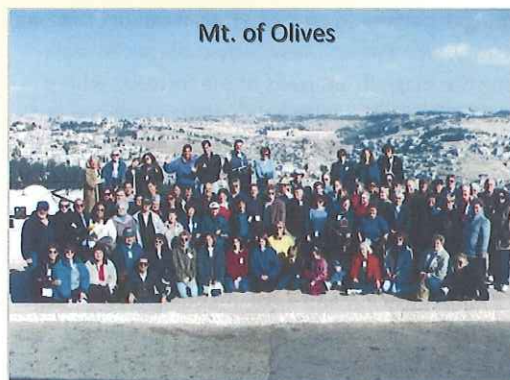

## The Holy Land

**Day 1 Sun, Dec 26: ATLANTA - EUROPE.** Tour members meet at the airport two hours prior to departure. Dinner and breakfast are served in flight.

**Day 2 Mon, Dec 27: EUROPE - TEL AVIV - JERUSALEM.** Upon our arrival in Tel Aviv, we are met and transferred to our beautiful hotel in Jerusalem where the thrilling journey of following in the footsteps of Jesus begins.

**Day 3 Tue, Dec 28: THE NEW CITY - THE MODEL CITY - MT. ZION - BETHLEHEM.** We begin the day with a tour New Jerusalem: the Shrine of the Book that houses the Dead Sea Scrolls and the Model City of Jerusalem which depicts in miniature the Holy City as it appeared in the first century. Then, we drive to Mt. Scopus and the Mt. of Olives (*Matthew 24:3*) for a panoramic view of the Old City of Jerusalem (*Mark 14:32-26*) and the Church of Agony where Jesus was betrayed by Judas (*Matthew 26:36-57*). Then, we visit the Valley of Elah (Azekah). Return to Bethlehem to visit the Church of the Nativity and the birthplace of Jesus, observing Rachel's tomb. Time for shopping before returning to Jerusalem for dinner and overnight at our hotel.

**Day 4 Wed, Dec 29: JERUSALEM - KIDRON VALLEY - HOUSE OF CAIAPHAS - THE UPPER ROOM - WESTERN WALL - TEMPLE MOUNT - THE OLD CITY.** After a good nights rest and a hearty breakfast, this exciting day begins with a morning drive through the Kidron Valley to the Pool of Siloam. We view the House of Caiaphas, the High Priest, and the first century steps of stone that our Lord climbed. We then continue to the Room of the Last Supper (*Luke 22:14-20*) on the summit of Mt. Zion where the tomb of King David is memorialized. Afterwards, we follow in the footsteps of Jesus through the Old City of Pilate's Judgment Hall, the Chapel of the Flagellation and the Ecce Homo Arch (*John 19:13*) where Jesus was tried before Pilate (*Mark 15:6*). Visit the Western (Wailing) Wall where

the faithful Jews cry their petitions to God, and continue to the Temple Area of Mt. Moriah. Visit the El Aksa Mosque and the Dome of the Rock that was built on the ancient site of Solomon's Temple (*Genesis 22:9-14*) and over the Rock of Sacrifice where Abraham offered Isaac (*Genesis 22*) and the ceremonial sacrifice of animals took place. Then continue through the Old City bazaars.

**Day 5 Thu, Dec 30: GARDEN TOMB - QUMRAN CAVES - VILLAGE OF THE ESSENES - EIN GEDI - DEAD SEA.** This morning, we visit the Garden Tomb and Golgotha - Place of the Skull - for a worship service. Then, we drive via the Judean Desert towards the Dead Sea, the lowest point on earth. A beautiful new road takes us south along the shores of the Dead Sea to Qumran where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered. Visit the remains of the Community Center of the Essenes and the Caves of the Scrolls. Then to Ein Gedi, a green oasis in the middle of the desert. Stop at the Dead Sea for an optional swim and time at leisure. Dinner and overnight at our hotel.

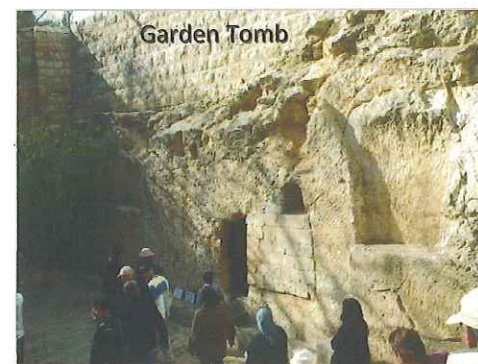
**Day 6 Fri, Dec 31: MASADA - ANCIENT JERICO - BEIT SHE'AN - TIBERIAS ON THE SEA OF GALILEE.** An early morning departure to Masada, truly a remarkable piece of history. We ascend Masada by cable car to walk among the magnificent ruins of the fortress, where from 70-73 A.D., the Jewish defenders made the last stand of the Judean revolt against Rome, and where the remains of storehouses, cisterns and a 6th century Byzantine church are still on view. Then, we drive through the Judean wilderness to Ancient Jericho where the walls came tumbling down (*I Kings 17:1-6* and *II Kings 2:19-22*) and a commanding view of the Mt. of Temptation (*Matthew 4:1-11*) and Elisha's Fountain. Stop for a visit at Beit She'an. We continue northward to the Province of Galilee. This evening, we check into our hotel on the shores of the beautiful Sea of Galilee.

**Day 7 Sat, Jan 1: TIBERIAS - SEA OF GALILEE - CAPERNAUM - MOUNT OF BEATITUDES - TABGHA - NAZARETH.** This will be an exciting day in the Galilee

area. After a delicious breakfast, we depart the Roman hot springs resort city of Tiberias via a boat ride across the Sea of Galilee to Capernaum (*John 6:24*) to see the ancient ruins of this first century synagogue where Jesus preached (*Matthew 4:13-17*). Then onto the Mt. of Beatitudes where Jesus preached the Sermon on the Mount (*Matthew 5-7*), and to Tabgha, the chapel dedicated to the multiplication of the loaves and fishes (*Mark 6:34-44*). We then proceed to Nazareth, the hometown of Jesus. We visit the Church of Annunciation (*Luke 1:5-42*) and Nazareth Village. Return to our hotel for overnight.

**Day 8 Sun, Jan 2: TIBERIAS - TEL AVIV.** Travelling westward across Galilee, we stop for a visit at Megiddo. Continue our drive northwest to Haifa and Mt. Carmel, the biblical site of Elijah's contest with the prophets of Baal (*I Kings 18*). Continue southward along the Way of the Sea to Caesarea, the Roman City of Herod where sights include Crusader fortifications and the Roman aqueducts and amphitheater. Drive through the citrus groves and farms of the rich land of Sharon to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

**Day 9 Mon, Jan 3: TEL AVIV - ATLANTA.** Early morning, we depart to the airport for our return flight to North America and home - The end of our wonderful journey.

**DEPOSITS/CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS:** The deposit of \$300.00 per person is required to confirm tour acceptance and will be applied to total price of program selected. 50% of remaining balance to be paid in full by July 16, 2010. Remaining balance to be paid in full 70 days prior to departure by October 16, 2010. A penalty of \$50.00 will be charged to those paying after the 70 day mark. After initial deposit is made \$200.00 cancellation fee applies for any cancellation received in writing up to 70 days prior to departure. 69 to 45 days prior to departure \$600.00 cancellation fee will be applied. **NO REFUND is possible under any circumstances for cancellations made within 45 days of departure.** Receipt of deposit for any partial payment of a tour constitutes acceptance of all terms and conditions listed herein. Passenger substitutions are not allowed after registration. **TOUR INSURANCE IS AVAILABLE AND STRONGLY RECOMMENDED. OUR CANCELLATION POLICY APPLIES TO INDIVIDUAL PASSENGERS, AND NOT FOR MASS CANCELLATIONS.
