

multi-site FAQs

Q. What is a multi-site church?

A. A multi-site church is one church in multiple locations with one staff, one Executive Team, one budget, one ministry model and philosophy, and one vision for the glory of God. For Cornerstone, the heart of becoming a multi-site church is about our mission - *Leading people to know and serve Jesus*. Our leadership feel strongly that this is not just another strategy that we chose on our own, but one that God has led us into for carrying out the mission He has given us.

Q. Where will the new site be?

A. Our new site will be located at Lee-Scott Academy on Academy Drive in Auburn, AL.

Q. How many services will there be at Lee-Scott?

A. We plan to start with one service and will grow to a second as the Lord grows the Lee-Scott site.

Q. Will there still be a children's ministry at Lee-Scott?

A. Yes! Both the goal and challenge of the Lee-Scott site is to recreate all the main elements that we currently experience at Cornerstone, including the great children's programming. Our plan is to take the DNA of our current children's ministry and bring it to the new site, with all the same attention, care, energy, and passion.

Q. Will there be staff dedicated to the Lee-Scott site?

A. Yes, initially we will start with a staff of three persons: Josh Agerton as the Site Pastor as well as a Worship Leader and Cornerstone Kids Site Director. While these staff persons will be focused on leading the Lee-Scott site, they will remain a part of the larger Cornerstone Staff Team.

Q. Will the Lee-Scott site provide a separate Youth Ministry for students in 7-12th grade?

A. No, students who attend Sunday morning worship at Lee-Scott will continue to gather for weekly "Cornerstone Youth" programming at the Hamilton Road site. Strategic Leaders of the youth ministry will be attending the Lee-Scott site in order to maintain a presence and connection with the youth on Sunday mornings.

Q. How will the messages be delivered at the Lee-Scott site and what will the worship be like?

A. Messages at the Lee-Scott site will predominately be delivered by video with live teaching happening at a minimum of 12 times a year. All of the worship will be led by a live band and in the same "Cornerstone" style.

Q. What is the target date for launching the Lee-Scott site?

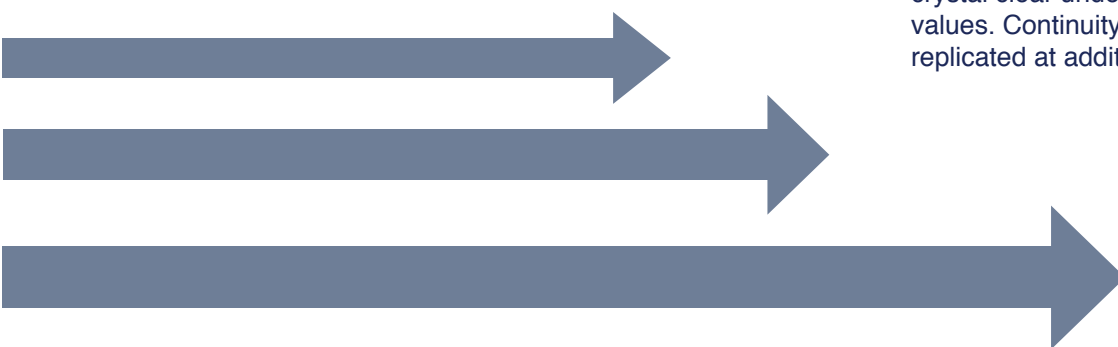
A. Our plan is to commission the Launch Team on January 29, 2012. The following Sunday, February 5th, will be the "Soft Launch" at Lee-Scott and three weeks later will be the public "Grand Opening"... Sunday February 26th, 2012!

Q. Are there plans to launch more new sites?

A. Our hope is to multiply our growth and maximize our impact in Lee County and East Alabama. The short-term vision for this involves becoming a church of three strategic locations within the next two years: one being at our current location, a second being at Lee-Scott that reaches more of North Auburn, and a third being located in Opelika.

Q. How will we as Cornerstone stay true to our identity and maintain unity as a multi-site church?

A. The most important factor in maintaining unity as one church in many locations is for us all to have a crystal clear understanding of our mission, DNA and values. Continuity and unity will come as these are replicated at additional sites.

•CONSIDER GOING.


Pick up a Commitment Card at the information desk any Sunday and turn in by *November 13th*.
