JOB DESCRIPTION

Philosophy of Ministry

Cornerstone Youth is Cornerstone's ministry to 6th-12th grade students. Our mission mirrors that of the church, "Leading Youth to Know and Serve Jesus." Using contemporary worship, relevant teaching, intimate small groups, and having dedicated volunteers, we strive to engage our students in a way that develops meaningful relationships.

This ministry position will report directly to the Youth Pastor and will be responsible for offering leadership to the Middle School ministry, as well as other responsibilities detailed below. The estimated workload will be 20-25 hours per week, including Sunday mornings and nights for Cornerstone Church and Cornerstone Youth.

Specific Responsibilities:

 - b. Primary teacher of Middle School large group teaching
 - c. Create / Adapt small group material to be relevant for Middle School
 - d. Meet and Connect with Volunteers and Students

 - a. Quarterly Mission Projects
 - b. OnMission
 - c. SafeHouse Atlanta
 - d. Potential Graduating Senior Uganda Trip
 - e. Empowering Small Groups for Missions
 - f. Plugging Youth into serving roles on Sunday Mornings (including Kidztown, Hospitality, etc...)

3. Middle School Youth Small Groups
 - a. Training
 - b. Mentoring
 - c. Recruiting
 - d. Providing Resources and Curriculum

4. Cornerstone Youth Teaching Team
 - a. Join the teaching team for Cornerstone Youth

5. Multi-Site
 - a. Help be a Youth Ministry presence at each of our campuses.
